### **Program Description**

The 2021 WVATA lecture series encompasses multiple domains of athletic training. The purpose of the conference is for participants to adapt information provided by program faculty and apply the knowledge within their practice. The focus of this course is administrative skills, emerging practices, and fracture/dislocation management for the athletic trainer. The program is aimed at enhancing the athletic trainer's clinical practice and administrative skills. This year's program will be delivered during two live virtual meetings. - 7. The attendee will learn the NATA Code of Ethics as it applies to sports gambling by the athletic trainer and protecting patient's private health information.
- 8. The attendee will apply ethical principles in their professional practice as it relates to refraining from gambling on sporting events and protection of patient's private health information.
- 9. Identify roles of athletic trainers in a physician's clinic
- 10. Describe the role of the athletic trainer from traditional role to how to assist and triage in a physician's clinic
- 11. Identify the emergent issues associated with a dislocation
- 12. Safely reduce dislocations of various joints
- 13. Appropriately splint/immobilize the injured area of post reduction
- 14. Develop written standing orders regarding management of dislocations
- 15. Describe the athletic trainer's role regarding student mentorship
